The market was driven by the increasing demand for emergency medical services, the rising prevalence of chronic diseases, and the aging population. In 2020, the global emergency medicine market was valued at \$19.6 billion, and it is expected to reach \$30.6 billion by 2027, growing at a CAGR of 6.5% from 2020 to 2027.
